## **Synopsis**

This course is to introduce basic theories and practices of International Organizations. First part of the course will deal with theories not only in international relations but also in international law on international organizations. Based on the understanding on the theories, the second part of the course will focus on the UN and other organizations which are located in Korea. In addition to scheduled lectures and presentations, other ad-hoc lecture(s) by guest speaker(s) will be organized to help students understand the practices of the international organizations in more detail.
